- Expectations

 - Priorities
 - As officers, what are our priorities?
 - Discuss and distribute 'Officer Contracts'

Review Council Goals and Priorities:

- Review Council Stats
 - Discuss red flags/areas of concern established by the Executive Council
 - The Executive Council and advisor have established the council's strategic goals and priorities
 - Each individual officer will set goals for a tactical area of the council
 - These goals need to support the achievement of the goals established by the Executive Council
 - Present the goal's established by the Executive Council
 - What is each goal and who is responsible for it?
 - Brainstorm what events/topics need to change and be the priority of the Council in order to achieve these goals?

Responsibilities and Resources:

- Who can help the Council achieve its goals?
 - Advisor
 - Student Affairs Office
 - Various Campus Resources
- Council Governance
 - Review where to locate Governing Documents and resources and set deadline for officers to review:
 - Constitution.
 - By-laws
 - Student Handbook
 - IFC Policy (i.e. Risk Management, Financial, Scholarship, etc)
